PSHE

This week Mrs Roberts has led a PSHE session with all year groups teaching them about, or recapping with them, using the Zones of Regulation. Each class will have a Zones grid in their class and will talk at various times with the staff about how they are feeling and what they can do to help themselves if they are not feeling in the green 'ready to work' zone.

The Zones of Regulation is a framework to support our children to develop self-regulation. Children learn to identify emotions, recognise events that might make them move to a different zone and use the tools they have learnt to help them remain or move to a particular zone to help them regulate how they are feeling.
